Code of Conduct

Alfold Hall is committed to providing a positive experience for everyone using or visiting the Hall, regardless of gender, gender identity and expression, age, sexual orientation, disability, physical appearance, body size, race, culture, ethnicity or religion. We do not tolerate abuse or harassment towards volunteers, contractors, hirers, visitors to the hall or the general public using the grounds adjacent to the hall.

Such abuse includes offensive comments or actions related to:-

- gender, gender identity and expression, age, sexual orientation, disability, physical appearance, body size, race, ethnicity, religion, culture
- deliberate intimidation, stalking, unwelcome sexual attention, harassing, or sustained disruption of meetings, talks or any other events

Anyone asked to stop abusive or harassing behaviour is expected to comply immediately. All those hiring, using or attending Alfold Hall are required to comply with this Code of Conduct.

If abusive or harassing behaviour is observed or reported, an Officer or a member of the Hall Committee may take whatever action they deem appropriate, including warning the offender, asking a person to leave the premises, or reporting to the police if behaviour is of serious concern.

If you are using the hall in any capacity (as hirer, volunteer or visitor) and feel that you are being abused or harassed, if you notice that someone else is being harassed, or if you have any other concerns regarding conduct, please contact Alfold Hall Committee via info@alfoldhall.co.uk
